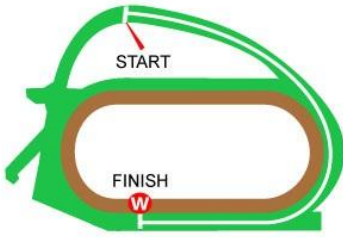

### Overseas Expert Column by Naohiro Goda

It is very exciting to have LUCKY SWEYNESSE from Hong Kong in the field of the 59th running of G1 Sprinters Stakes at Nakayama on 28th September. I understand two horses, LUCKY SWEYNESSE and SATONO REVE, are far superior in strength in this field. It is obvious, and then, it is not easy decision which horse I should choose as my favorite.

LUCKY SWEYNESSE achieved hat trick of Sprint Series in 2023. Unfortunately, he suffered left fore fetlock injury after he won G2 Sprint Cup in April 2024 and sidelined for one year. He was back to racing in April 2025 and ran twice by the end of season. While his performances earlier this year were not so brilliant, LUCKY SWEYNESSE ran much better at Sha Tin on 7th September, finishing second to KA YING RISING, and I have an impression that he is now bouncing back at his top form.

I regard SATONO REVE as the best sprinter in Japan after LORD KANALOA. He won G1 Takamatsunomiya Kinen and finished second both in G1 Chairman's Sprint Prize at Sha Tin and G1 Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee Stakes at Royal Ascot earlier this year, could be the second best. He spent easy time at Yashi Racing Ranch at Hokkaido, since he returned from UK, and moved to satellite yard of Noriyuki Hori at Hakodate Racecourse to resume full training on 14th August. He was transferred to Miho Training Center earlier this month and breezed with Joao Moreira in the irons at woodchip course for six furlongs on 19th September. It was very impressive workout and I am sure SATONO REVE is ready to run his race on Sunday. As Nakayama is home course for SATONO REVE, I select SATONO REVE as my first choice and LUCKY SWEYNESSE is my second choice.

My third choice is TOSHIN MACAU, who finished second in G1 Sprinters Stakes in 2024. Though he was beaten third in G2 Centaurs Stakes at Hanshin on 7th September, it was first start for him since May, and I think it was a good effort.

My fourth choice is LUGAL, winner of G1 Sprinters Stakes in 2024. Although he has not run a race since April, I am not worried about it as he won Sprinters Stakes in 2024 without having any prep race.

My fifth choice is MAMA COCHA, winner of Sprinters Stakes in 2023. While she is 6YO now, I believe she is still keeping her strength and competitive mind.

## Track Analysis by Naohiro Goda

Nakayama is a clockwise oval track with two routes for turf course - the inner track and the outer track, and a dirt course. The outer track branches off from the inner track at the exit of near turn and rejoins the inner track at the entrance of far turn. The homestretches for the turf course and dirt course are 310m and 308m respectively. Meanwhile, it is the tendency at Nakayama that the tempo is picked up at the middle of far turn, and the runners who hold endurance and stamina enjoy better result than runners who hold sharp turn of foot.

Starting gate for the 1200m Sprinters Stakes, it is set at the beginning of backstretch and there is 275m long straight from the starting gate to the beginning of far turn. Statistics show middle number is preferable at this course and distance. Given the short homestretch, tactical speed is always the key to success and it is a tendency that front runners and runners who track leaders closely enjoy better result. But with the upslope in the final 200m, closers are not denied.

## Lucky Sweynesse pleases in turf gallop ahead of Sprinters Stakes challenge

Wednesday, 24/9/2025

Lucky Sweynesse's preparation for Sunday's (28 September) G1 Sprinters Stakes (1200m) saw the four-time Group 1 winner gallop gracefully over Nakayama's turf course under beaming sunshine this morning (Wednesday, 24 September) in Tokyo, Japan.

Trainer Manfred Man and owners the Cheng family watched on delighted as the seven-year-old brown gelding powered up the 310m-long uphill home straight under restraint from jockey Derek Leung, who with Lucky Sweynesse, is aiming to secure Hong Kong, China's third win in the prized contest this weekend after Silent Witness (2005) and Ultra Fantasy (2010).

"He feels great. He always looks around like he does in Hong Kong, always curious with everything. It was his first time galloping here but everything went smoothly," Leung said.

After his hit-out, Lucky Sweynesse – exuding swagger and confidence – returned to a swarm of photographers and then made a few laps around the paddock before heading to the Japan Racing Association's international stables at Nakayama.

Man said: "He worked very good. The jockey reported that the horse feels very fit. Today was just to see him gallop. In Hong Kong, we already know that his form keeps coming. In my mind, I am happy about the horse.

"He had two runs last season and came sixth and fourth. Beginning this season, he came second in the (Class 1 HKSAR) Chief Executive's Cup (Handicap, 1200m) and the track that day wasn't really suitable for him, but he still came second behind the best (sprinter) in the world (Ka Ying Rising)."

Sporting a visor first-up on 7 September in the HKSAR Chief Executive's Cup under persistent rain at Sha Tin, Lucky Sweynesse will again don headwear this Sunday when he squares off with Group 1 winners Satono Reve, Lugal, Mama Cocha and more at Nakayama, a picturesque racetrack located in the Chiba Prefecture of the Greater Tokyo Area.

Speaking of Lucky Sweynesse's added gear, Man said: "Now as his age is getting a bit older, we need a little bit of support to keep him more concentrated (in races)."

Lucky Sweynesse began his career as an unraced three-year-old with debut success at Happy Valley in 2022, the former Hong Kong Champion Sprinter (2022/23) has won 16 times from 27 starts in Hong Kong for earnings of HK\$75.75 million.

Sparingly raced over the last year due to surgery and setbacks, Lucky Sweynesse's biggest wins have come in the 2023 G1 LONGINES Hong Kong Sprint (1200m), 2023 G1 Centenary Sprint Cup (1200m), 2023 G1 Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup (1400m) and 2023 G1 Chairman's Sprint Prize (1200m).

He is one of only five horses to claim the HK\$5 million Hong Kong Speed Series bonus, doing so in the 2022/23 season, along with Mr Vitality (1995/96), Grand Delight (2002/03), Silent Witness (2003/04 & 2004/05) and Ka Ying Rising (2024/25). The three-race bonus rewards a horse successful in the Centenary Sprint Cup, Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup and Chairman's Sprint Prize in the same season.

First run in 1967, Sunday's edition of the Sprinters Stakes is the 59th running. The Hong Kong Jockey Club will simulcast the race, scheduled to jump at 2.40pm (HKT).

Barriers for the Sprinters Stakes are drawn on Friday (26 September) at 9am (JST).

## Lucky Sweynesse ‘fulfilling a dream’ for Cheng family with Japan odyssey

Thursday, 25/9/2025

Lucky Sweynesse will make his owners’ dreams come true this Sunday (28 September) when he heads to the starting gates for the G1 Sprinters Stakes (1200m) at Nakayama in Tokyo, Japan.

The former Hong Kong Champion Sprinter (2022/23) is owned by the Cheng family – Cheng Ming Leung, Cheng Yu Tung, Cheng Mei Mei and Cheng Yu Wai – passionate racing enthusiasts who are on the cusp of realising a long-held ambition when Lucky Sweynesse boldly flies the Bauhinia flag for Hong Kong, China against the best of Japan.

Cheng Ming Leung, father of Cheng Yu Tung, Cheng Mei Mei and Cheng Yu Wai, said: “Coming to race in Japan is fulfilling a dream. I came here with my friend Mr Wong in 2008, and he owned Armada, who was second in the Yasuda Kinen (G1, 1600m) that year.

“It was an amazing experience for me and my family, so one day I always wanted to come here. Mr Wong will be coming to Japan this time to support us on Sunday here.”

Armada was a valiant second behind dual Japanese Horse of the Year (2008 & 2009) Vodka at Tokyo 17 years ago and it was that very defeat and experience which sparked a fire of ambition for the family, who have successfully owned a string of racehorses in Macau as well, to embark on their own journey some 2,800km from Hong Kong to Japan with their pride and joy – Lucky Sweynesse.

Eldest son Cheng Yu Tung, whose English name is Michael, embraces the vision: “We are very happy to be here. The JRA (Japan Racing Association) has been so welcoming to us. This is our dream to race him in Japan. This is our family dream to come here. We are here right now – it’s very exciting.

“Even just racing here is very exciting. We hope he will perform well, but we are very calm about it and just enjoying the moment.”

The proud family – sporting Lucky Sweynesse T-shirts – watched their champion horse’s every move at trackwork this week, eagle-eyed and smiling from ear to ear, sharing conversations and taking photos with media ahead of their campaign’s climax this weekend.

Horse ownership is built on the hope of scaling the highest of highs – Group 1 glory, a summit Lucky Sweynesse has reached four times. His earnings for the family – who operate a trading business between Hong Kong and the Mainland – are HK\$75.75 million.

Cheng Ming Leung said: “Racing is a family day for us. We always meet on race days and have fun together – family day and watching horses. We built up our interest and began owning more horses.”

Michael said: “I’ve liked horse racing since I was young. I went to the racecourse with my father – he raced many horses in Macau and Hong Kong. When I was 18, I started to go racing. The whole family – horse racing is our family gathering day.

“Every Wednesday and Sunday we meet at the racecourse in Hong Kong. It’s our common interest and hobby – we like horse racing very much.”

The family has three horses racing in Hong Kong: Lucky Sweynesse, Lucky Statement and Lucky Field. The brilliant Lucky Sweynesse is the banner horse of the trio, a courageous gelding who lifted their yellow and turquoise silks to international prominence and who also boasts his own plush toy collection at The Hong Kong Jockey Club’s ‘Gift at Races’.

Cheng Yu Wai, whose English name is Leo, said: “It’s our honour to be here representing Hong Kong. It is our dream and it’s great to be here. I think he will run pretty well. He looks better and better after his injury. Me and my brother Michael do the purchasing – we love it.”

Lucky Sweynesse is aiming to add to his elite-level victories in the 2023 G1 LONGINES Hong Kong Sprint (1200m), 2023 G1 Centenary Sprint Cup (1200m), 2023 G1 Queen’s Silver Jubilee Cup (1400m) and 2023 G1 Chairman’s Sprint Prize (1200m).

Trained by Manfred Man and to be ridden by Derek Leung, Lucky Sweynesse is one of four Group 1 winners in Sunday’s race. Satono Reve – who has placed behind Ka Ying Rising – is the likely favourite in Japan after his G1 Takamatsunomiya Kinen (1200m) score at Chukyo in March.

Lucky Sweynesse has raced three times since a Group 2 victory in April, 2024. The seven-year-old underwent surgery on his left fore fetlock, causing him to miss over 12 months of competition before returning for a sixth-placing, a fourth and a last-start second to Ka Ying Rising in the Class 1 HKSAR Chief Executive’s Cup Handicap (1200m) on 7 September.

The mighty Silent Witness (2005) and the unheralded Ultra Fantasy (2010) are Hong Kong, China’s previous two winners of the Sprinters Stakes. At odds of 31/1, Ultra Fantasy surprised as an eight-year-old with an all-the-way victory under Alex Lai for trainer Ricky Yiu.

First run in 1967, Sunday’s edition of the Sprinters Stakes is the 59th running. The Hong Kong Jockey Club will simulcast the race, scheduled to jump at 2.40pm (HKT).

Barriers for the Sprinters Stakes are drawn tomorrow (Friday, 26 September) at 9am (JST).

## Derek Leung proud to be in Japan with Lucky Sweynesse for Sprinters Stakes

Friday, 26/9/2025

Derek Leung will carry an immense sense of pride to the races in Tokyo, Japan this weekend as he relishes the challenge of international competition and representing Hong Kong, China aboard Lucky Sweynesse in the G1 Sprinters Stakes (1200m) at Nakayama.

Leung, 37, has 499 Hong Kong wins and will aim to become only the fourth local rider – after Tony Cruz, Vincent Ho and Matthew Chadwick – to reach the 500-win milestone at next Wednesday's (1 October) National Day fixture at Sha Tin. Before that, though, he will take two mounts on Saturday (27 September) at Nakayama in readiness for his pairing with Lucky Sweynesse on Sunday (28 September).

"I can't wait for this Sunday. It's my honour to represent Hong Kong. I'm very lucky to have the trainer and owner's support to go overseas and ride. I hope everything goes smooth and that we can run a good race," Leung said. "My dream is to try and get as many winners as I can and win Group 1s as well. If I am lucky enough to represent Hong Kong overseas, for me, it's an honour and a big achievement."

Leung links with Smart Weiss in the Shufu Stakes (1600m) and Sumire First in the programme's finale (Race 12) on Saturday. Smart Weiss is a three-time winner from seven starts. The son of Lord Kanaloa sports the familiar pink and black colours of owner Toru Okawa, who raced dual Sha Tin winner Smart Charade with trainer Chris So.

"I have two rides on Saturday in races 11 and 12. I will see the draws and try to get good results. Thank you to the owners for their support," Leung said.

Aboard Lucky Sweynesse in trackwork this week, Leung has gained a valuable feel ahead of the weekend for Nakayama's unique contours, featuring a long sweeping back section which heads downhill before turning into a short home straight (310m) with a steep incline.

The Manfred Man-trained Lucky Sweynesse steps from gate 10 in Sunday's Sprinters Stakes against 15 rivals, including Satono Reve (barrier seven) – who brings Ka Ying Rising and Royal Ascot form to Nakayama – as well as Mama Cocha (four), Namura Clair (six), Toshin Macau (11), Lugal (15) and Win Carnelian (16).

"You can see Satono Reve has performed very well in Hong Kong, Europe and Japan. Of course, he is a hot favourite here. I think, I respect all of the horses, it's a very strong field and hopefully we can get some luck and a good result," Leung said.

"The draw is a bit wide. We will see on Saturday and Sunday what the racecourse is like, coming from behind, midfield or forward. We'll try to plan it out later. There are quite a few leaders positioned outside, so they need to work a bit to get in."

A product of The Hong Kong Jockey Club's Apprentice Jockeys' School, Leung has won two Group 1 races in Hong Kong aboard Beauty Generation in the 2017 G1 LONGINES Hong Kong Mile (1600m) and Victor The Winner in the 2024 G1 Centenary Sprint Cup (1200m), although success aboard Lucky Sweynesse this Sunday profiles as a new pinnacle for Leung.

"His fitness is improving. We know his action is fine and that he keeps getting better and better, but with this class you need to be in top form to run well. This season, he sounds good, though the weather limited him to less training before the season started because of the rain," Leung said.

Man, 68, became a fully-fledged trainer in 2001. He won the 1979 QEII Cup on Go-Getter as a jockey before climbing the local ranks as an assistant trainer, notably under the tutelage of John Moore.

Earlier this month, Man united with jockey Jerry Chau as the second all-local combination to win a race abroad – a feat that he is aiming to repeat on Sunday with Leung – in South Korea's G3 Korea Sprint (1200m, sand) on 7 September. Trainer Ricky Yiu and Alex Lai first secured the landmark with Ultra Fantasy in the 2010 Sprinters Stakes.

"My horse's form is very well. We are all satisfied about this trip and everything is fine. He has come to Japan and at first, he feels like a stranger, but after a few days it looks like he loves Japan more than Hong Kong," Man said. "We feel that everything is fine. The draw is a little bit wide and the better chances from Japan have a better draw."

The trainer has worked Lucky Sweynesse each day on the turf course at Nakayama since Wednesday's (24 September) final gallop, citing added experience as the reason ahead of Sunday's 59th running of the Sprinters Stakes.

"In Hong Kong the grass track isn't always open. In Japan over these few days, they have opened the grass track for us each day, so we decided to have the horse practice on the grass track so that he can get more experience," Man said. "Thank you to the JRA (Japan Racing Association) for inviting us to race here. I hope my horse gets a good result."

Barrier 10 is the joint-second most successful draw since 1990 (to 2024) with five wins, equal to gate 13, while barrier eight leads the way with seven winners.

Overall, 16 attempts have been made by runners from Hong Kong to capture the Sprinters Stakes, with Silent Witness (2005) the only other triumphant, along with Ultra Fantasy.

## Satono Reve chases Group 1 Sprinters Stakes under Joao Moreira

Friday, 26/9/2025

Globetrotting jockey Joao Moreira is confident Satono Reve is in peak form as the star Japanese galloper attempts to snare the G1 Sprinters Stakes (1200m) at Nakayama Racecourse near Tokyo, Japan on Sunday (28 September).

The winner of the G1 Takamatsunomiya Kinen (1200m) at Chukyo Racecourse in March, Satono Reve will face 15 rivals this weekend as he attempts to emulate the feats of a select group of outstanding sprinters including Flower Park, Trot Star, Laurel Guerreiro, Lord Kanaloa and Fine Needle, who are the only horses to win Japan's two Group 1 sprints in the same season.

Threatening the aspirations of Satono Reve's trainer Noriyuki Hori is an imposing band of proven Group 1 performers, including Lucky Sweynesse, who is bidding to become the fourth overseas-trained horse to win the Sprinters Stakes after fellow Hong Kong, China pair Silent Witness (2005) and Ultra Fantasy (2010) and Australia's Takeover Target (2006).

The presence of the past two Sprinters Stakes winners – Mama Cocha (2023) and Lugal (2024) – as well as Namura Clair, who finished third in this race in 2023 and 2024, potentially complicates Satono Reve's challenge of converting outstanding form on the international stage into domestic glory.

Resuming after finishing second in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee Stakes (1200m) to Lazzat at Royal Ascot in June – which followed his second to the world's top-rated sprinter Ka Ying Rising in the G1 Chairman's Sprint Prize (1200m) at Sha Tin in April – Satono Reve has impressed Moreira in the lead-up to this weekend's feature.

Assessing the six-year-old's 10.7s surge over the final 200m at the end of a 1200m gallop in 1m 23.0s at Miho Training Center, Moreira said: "The response when I asked was excellent. From the 400-metre to the 200-metre mark, he gave me a powerful run. His condition is excellent."

Moreira has ridden Satono Reve five times for two wins, two seconds and a third.

Satono Reve started favourite in the 2024 Sprinters Stakes when ridden by Damian Lane, finishing seventh when beaten around two and a quarter lengths by Lugal, who has struggled to produce his best in three runs since for trainer Haruki Sugiyama.

Lucky Sweynesse appears to have settled in well at Nakayama, pleasing trainer Manfred Man and jockey Derek Leung as the four-time Group 1 winner prepares to make his overseas debut.

Returning after leg surgery, Lucky Sweynesse has been conservatively raced by Man, but the seven-year-old's effort to finish second behind Ka Ying Rising in the Class 1 HKSAR Chief Executive's Cup Handicap (1200m) at Sha Tin on 7 September pleased the veteran horseman, and he is satisfied with the sprinter's work since arriving in Japan.

"The workout this morning went very well and the jockey said so, too. The horse was very fit and in good shape. I felt it was a good result for the test run," Man said after Lucky Sweynesse's final preparation gallop on Wednesday (24 September).

"Today, we just came to see him again, but in Hong Kong, we already know the horse. His form keeps coming. In my mind, I'm happy about the horse."

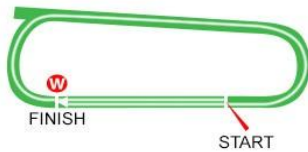

## Overseas Expert Column by Catrin Nack

The World Pool is back on German soil, simulcasting the 63<sup>rd</sup> running of the Preis von Europa, a G1 event over 2400m. As open-age races over this trip in Germany come, the race is second in importance only to the Grosser Preis von Baden, covered by the World Pool three weeks ago; the race is the highlight of the Cologne racing season. With rain forecast and cooler temperatures starting to set in in Germany, the ground, currently a mix of good-soft and soft ground proper, will certainly have some give by Sunday.

ALLENO represents the older German generation. In the colours of one of Germany's major owner-breeders who pays for an English jockey to take the reins, this colt has always been highly thought of, but somehow had a hit-and-miss career so far. He started this year with a bang when taking a G2 over this course and distance in April, but didn't run again until early September when he may have needed the run in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden. On ratings he is one of the obvious contenders for a finish in the top three.

Two 4YO colts travel over from France. COLUMBUS is trained by Christophe Ferland, and is German-owned. His owner-breeder's gamble to have this well-bred colt trained in France hasn't fully paid off yet, but COLUMBUS was a G3 winner over 3000m in France last year, as well as being multiple Listed-placed. A dour stayer, connections no doubt hope he can raise the profile of his family even further.

Francis-Henri Graffard sends SIBAYAN, who runs in the world-famous colours of the late Aga Khan. His 3YO season was cut short slightly, but this talented stayer made up for lost time in 2025. Five starts this term resulted in three wins, with two second places to boot. He had G1 winner JUNKO behind, and met - and beat - COLUMBUS too; his latest runaway win in the G2 Grand Prix de Deauville over 2500m was another step up. He is the logical favourite and the one they all have to beat.

Last but by no means least are two mares who take on the boys. Germany sends EGINA, a 4YO who took her form to a new level when taking a G2 against her own sex earlier this month. A three-time winner from four starts this year, she must rank as one of the best older fillies or mares in training in Germany. This is another step up in class, but she has hardly done a lot wrong so far. A slight worry may be that her best form has come left-handed, coincidental as that may have been; but her form is rock-solid and she took the step up to today's trip in style latest.

This leaves TIFFANY, who travels over from England. Her trainer Sir Mark Prescott has an uncanny knack for not only training fillies and mares. He knows the German racing calendar inside-out and has raided domestic G1's with fillies and mares on multiple occasions over the years. TIFFANY is no stranger to these shores herself: in fact she is three from four in this country. Her sole defeat in Germany was a narrow second in a G1 in Munich in November last year. Her British form is well up to scratch, but she hasn't been seen since that second place in Munich, so does make her seasonal debut here. It would be another feather in the cap of her legendary trainer if she can beat the boys straight away.

## Track Analysis by Catrin Nack

Racing returns to Germany on Sunday, to Cologne racecourse to be precise. The G1 Preis von Europa over 2400m is one of seven races of the highest class to be staged in Germany, another one run over the Classic Derby trip. The race is open to 3YO and elders of all sexes, including geldings. First run in the early 1960s, the race has an impressive list of winners and has always been a lucrative port of call for foreign raiders.

Cologne racecourse is right-handed and flat, and is known as a good galloping track. The track is roughly 2000m in circumference, with its straight roughly 500m long. Starting stalls for the main event are positioned at the top of the straight, with a fair run to the first bend. While in very large fields the outside draw can be seen as some sort of disadvantage, there is no draw bias as such as the runners have ample time to find a position before they reach the first bend. Seasonal conditions determine ground conditions as cool temperatures at night and heavy dew in the morning mean wet ground that can be lose on top.

Cologne stages 11 race days from the end of March till early November. The G1 Preis von Europa is the only top-level race run at the track and is a highlight not just of the local calendar but of the German season overall. The race is sandwiched between Baden and the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe on the first Sunday in October, but still has an impressive list of honour. Scrolling through the list of winners one sees a veritable list of domestic and international stars, and no real favour for any one age-group.

Rain is forecast for later in the week, so it might pay to look for horses that want some cut in the ground. There won't be any extremes though, so the stage is set of hopefully yet another fascinating betting heat.

## Sibayan looks the horse to beat in Sunday's Group 1 Preis von Europa

Friday, 26/9/2025

Sunday's (28 September) 63rd running of the G1 Preis von Europa (2400m) is the highlight of the Cologne racing season and one of the focal points of Germany's whole year, with an honour roll featuring some of the finest German horses and jockeys.

Overseas-trained winners include the 2021 victor Alpinista, who went on to land ParisLongchamp's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (2400m) the following year.

Peter Schiergen has trained the winner five times and also won it as a jockey. He handles Path Of Soldier and Egina – two of the seven declared runners – with stable jockey Andrasch Starke staying loyal to Path Of Soldier ahead of the upwardly mobile filly Egina.

Path Of Soldier is in the top rank of German-trained three-year-olds this year. He won Munich's G3 Bavarian Classic (2000m) in May and two starts later was a creditable fourth in the G1 Deutsches Derby (2400m) before running slightly below expectations in this month's G1 Grosser Preis von Baden (2400m).

Starke – who has won the Preis von Europa four times and all for Schiergen – says: "I wasn't available early in the season (when riding in Japan) but he was my Derby mount, so why change it now? We are still not sure about his best trip but will roll the dice over this distance one more time."

Of Egina (Leon Wolff), Starke says: "No distance worries for her and she won well at Baden Baden (G2 T. Von Zastrow Stutenpreis, 2400m). The ground (predicted to be slow) will be fine for both of them. I see Sibayan as the main danger but of course Tiffany has good form in the book as well."

Sibayan runs in the famous colours of the late Aga Khan and is trained by Francis Graffard. The four-year-old gelding has stamina all over his pedigree and has improved notably over distances up to 2800m. He is a dual Group 2 winner this year, quickening clear in last month's Grand Prix de Deauville (2500m). Partnered as usual by Mickael Barzalona, he is the highest-rated runner and the logical favourite.

It will be a surprise if the two other French-trained runners – stablemates Columbus and Think Giant – can make a winning impact, though the stamina-laden Columbus is likely to push forward in an attempt to expose any endurance issues in his opponents.

Tiffany is a class act and has demonstrated her effectiveness in this exalted company with a battling second in Munich's G1 Preis von Bayern (2400m). This will be her first start since that effort last November - recovering from a back injury - but Tiffany has won after an absence before. She has a decent chance of giving Alpinista's Newmarket-based trainer Sir Mark Prescott another victory in this.

Meanwhile, Newmarket-based rider Robert Havlin has been called up for the ride on the Marcel Weiss-trained Alleno. The colt showed his appreciation for this course and distance when easily landing the G2 Sauren Dachfonds Preis (2400m) here in April.
